

The Rules



This is a show for pleasure, and the company of others who share your interest in vintage British machinery. In this vein, judging is by popular vote of your peers, each of whom has a car entered in the show. Each entrant receives one ballot, and may cast one vote per class.

Based on early registration results, classes are created for each major marque, and certain subdivisions within marques. Where there are not sufficient early entries to justify a separate class, entries will be grouped by type of car (other sedans, sports cars, etc.)

Drive-up registration is open from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. No cars will be entered after that time. No "For Rent/Sale" signs allowed on the show field.

In order to be ready for the Awards Ceremony at 2:00 p.m., balloting closes at 12:30 p.m. sharp. Ballots received after that time will not be included in the scoring count.



Lunch

This year, we are pleased to announce that food will be available at the Hunt Country Classic show from two quality vendors.

Crepe Deli will be serving breakfast, lunch and snack items. The offerings will include hot deli and dessert crepes, crab cakes, hamburgers, sausages and frozen desserts. A selection of beverages will also be available. Crepe Deli is based in Alexandria, Virginia and provides food services at fairs, craft shows, festivals and at special upscale events in the greater Washington, D.C. area.

The Carousel of Warrenton, Virginia will be serving premium soft-serve ice cream at the Hunt Country Classic.

All food sales will be on a cash-only basis.

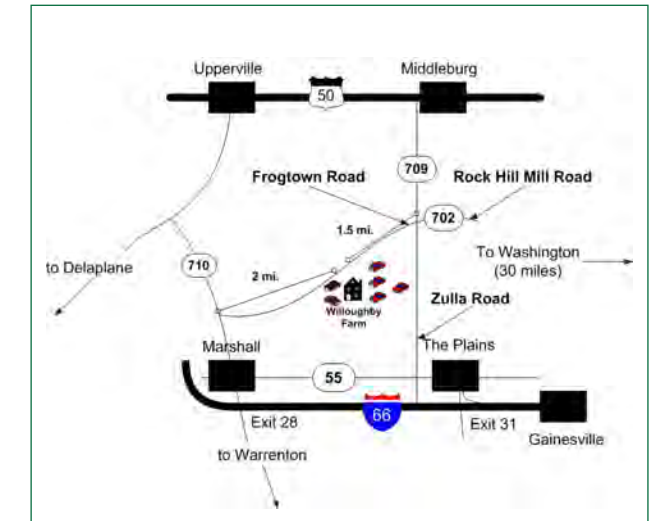
The Event
