**Policy Statement for the inclusion of
Replicas, Reproductions and Kit Cars**

I. Purpose: The intent of this document is to define the policy for the inclusion of Replicas, Reproductions and Kit Cars (referred to as reproduction vehicles henceforth) for display at the Hunt Country Classic British car show as presented by the MG Car Club Washington D.C. Centre.

II. Problem: As reproduction of British automobiles has been and remains popular they are appearing at more and more British car shows. Even when the reproduction itself originates from Great Britain, its place among authentic vehicles must be carefully addressed. On occasion, reproduction vehicles have been presented and/or registered as authentic vehicles, further complicating the issue.

III. Findings: It is the conclusion of the MG Car Club Washington D.C. Centre that any vehicle deemed or admitted to be a reproduction, regardless of quality or value will be placed not with those makes or models which it replicates but in a separate, reproduction class. Furthermore, the MG Car Club Washington D.C. Centre will make every effort to only allow reproduction vehicles of British origin onto the show field.

IV. Conclusion: As the quality of some reproductions reach higher and higher levels of authenticity, the honesty and integrity of those show entrants owning such automobiles is both necessary and expected. All protests as a result of this policy or its enforcement will be thoroughly considered by the show Chairpersons. The show Chairpersons reserve the right and authority to reclassify any vehicle exhibited on the show grounds at any time as deemed appropriate, in accordance with this policy.
